A few years ago ,my wife came up with a great idea, that uses part of your window fly trap strips, to catch deerflies and horseflies.

What, she does is cut a 3 inch part of your strip and attaches it to the back of the hat. The first time, I used it, on a 15 min walk, in our bush, it captured over 40 deerflies, and actually made the walk very pleasant, as compared to unbearable. We have also made up smaller strips that we use for our dogs, placing them at the back of their heads, this enables us to walk them in the bush, even at the height of deerfly season. I believe, they could also be useful for larger animals like horses or cows.

A lot of our friends are now using your strips and using my wife's idea's. Maybe, there's a market here, you may, not have looked at?
